## CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT LUCAS D. SHAY

Chief Master Sergeant Lucas D. Shay is both the Career Field Manager for Air Force Safety and the Functional Manager for Air Education and Training Command Safety, Joint Base San Antonio-Randolph, Texas. As Career Field Manager, Chief Shay leads more than 360 1S0X1 personnel worldwide. He develops and maintains Department of the Air Force safety policy, formulates enlisted specialty descriptions, manages enlisted development, establishes training and resource requirements, and resolves career field utilization and training deficiencies. CMSqt Shay also advises the DAF Chief of Safety on issues from within the Air Force Safety Center as well as the 1S0X1 career field, fostering effectiveness across the Safety enterprise. As AETC Safety Functional Manager, Chief Shay orchestrates Aviation, Occupational, and Explosive mishap prevention programs for more than 60,000 assigned command personnel as well as 293,000 Total Force trainees via the Air Force Recruiting Service and Air University.

Chief Master Sergeant Shay entered the Air Force in May 2004. He graduated from the Ground Radio Communications Apprentice Course at Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi, in February 2005. His background includes a variety of positions with significant experience in Ground Radio, Airfield Systems, and Safety. His assignments include bases in Virginia, Massachusetts, Mississippi, and Texas as well as overseas in South Korea, Portugal, Germany, and the United Kingdom. He has also deployed in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM and Combined Joint Task Force - Horn of Africa.
