The 2024 Department of the Air Force Safety Hall of Fame is presented to Mr. Daniel H. Stanton, Pentagon, Washington, D.C. Throughout his 27 years of exceptional service, Mr. Stanton served in Department of Defense safety positions at the Numbered Air Force, Air Force Safety Center, and Headquarters Air Force Safety levels. For the last 22 years, Mr. Stanton served under and guided fifteen different Air Force Chiefs of Safety providing continuity in the Chief Safety Pentagon office. He made notable contributions to safety initiatives while serving as Chief and Deputy Chief, Safety Issues division during that time. Mr. Stanton developed and implemented the Headquarters-level Open Recommendations review process now known as the Hazard Review Board. Additionally, he developed, implemented, and served as Executive Secretary for the Vice Chief of Staff of the Air Force-chaired Air Force Operational Safety Council comprised of Deputy Commanders from the Major Commands and the Air Staff Two-Letters. Mr. Stanton's trailblazing initiative yielded membership on the initial cadre of Air Staff representatives to the Programming Budget Review Group. The results of his efforts continue to aid the securing of funding for critical safety programs. The distinctive accomplishments of Mr. Stanton culminate a distinguished career with the United States Government and reflect great credit upon himself and the Department of the Air Force.
