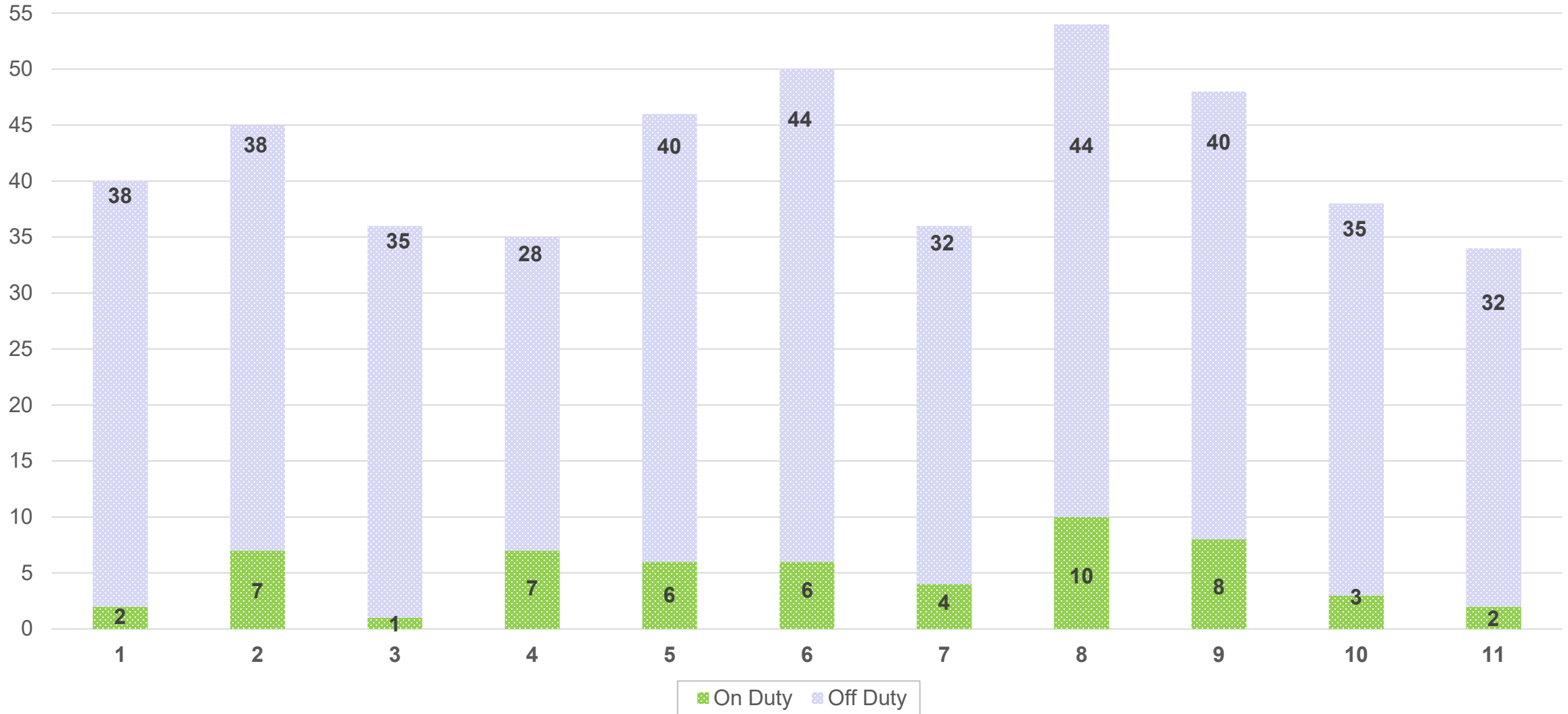

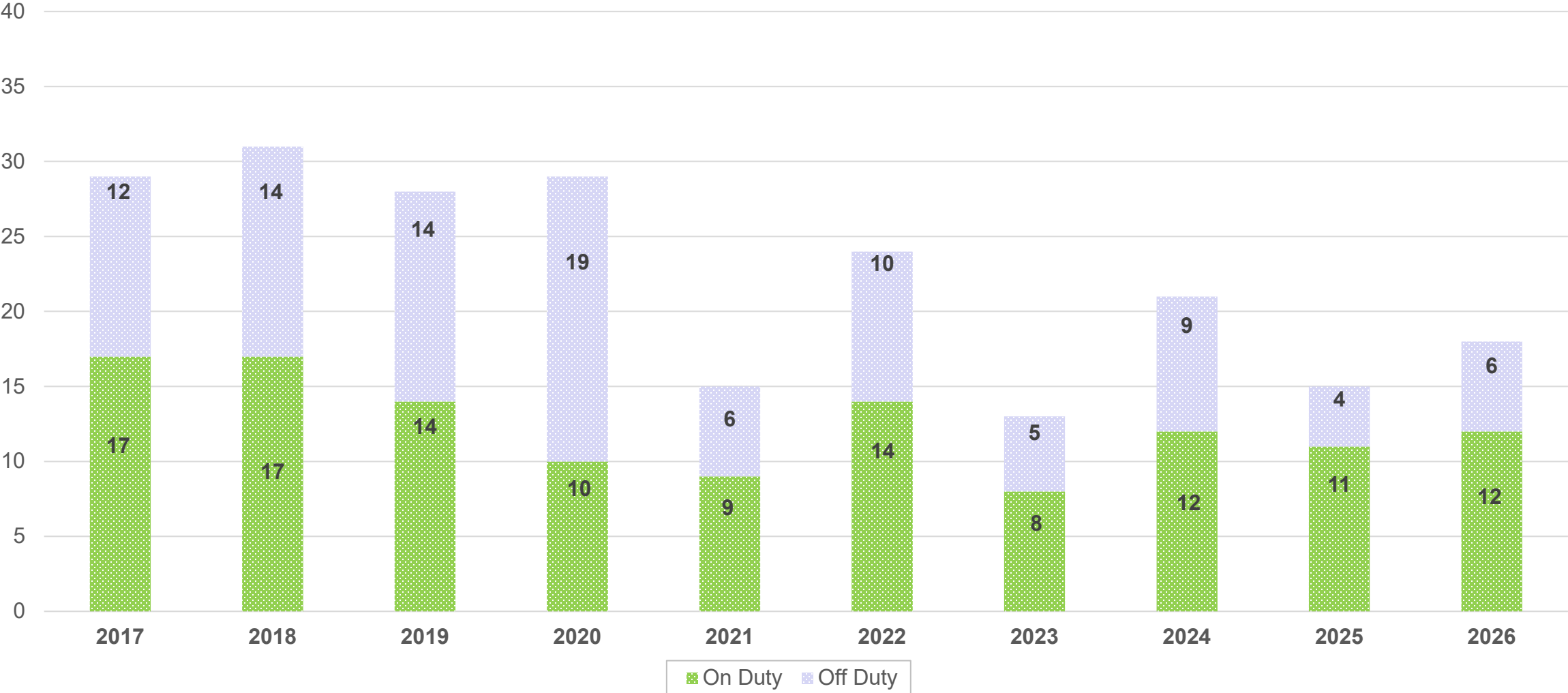
Occupational Safety Class A Mishaps

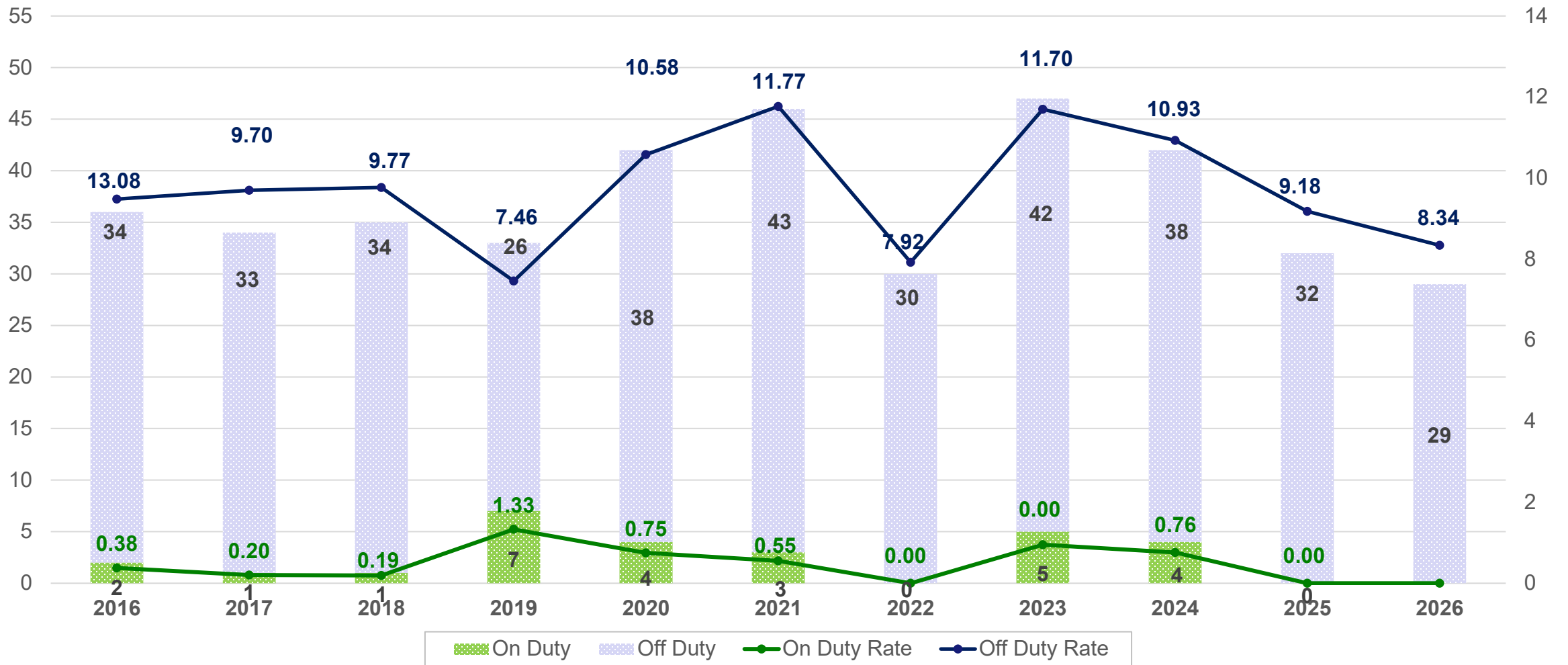
Occupational Safety Class B Mishaps

Occupational Safety Fatalities

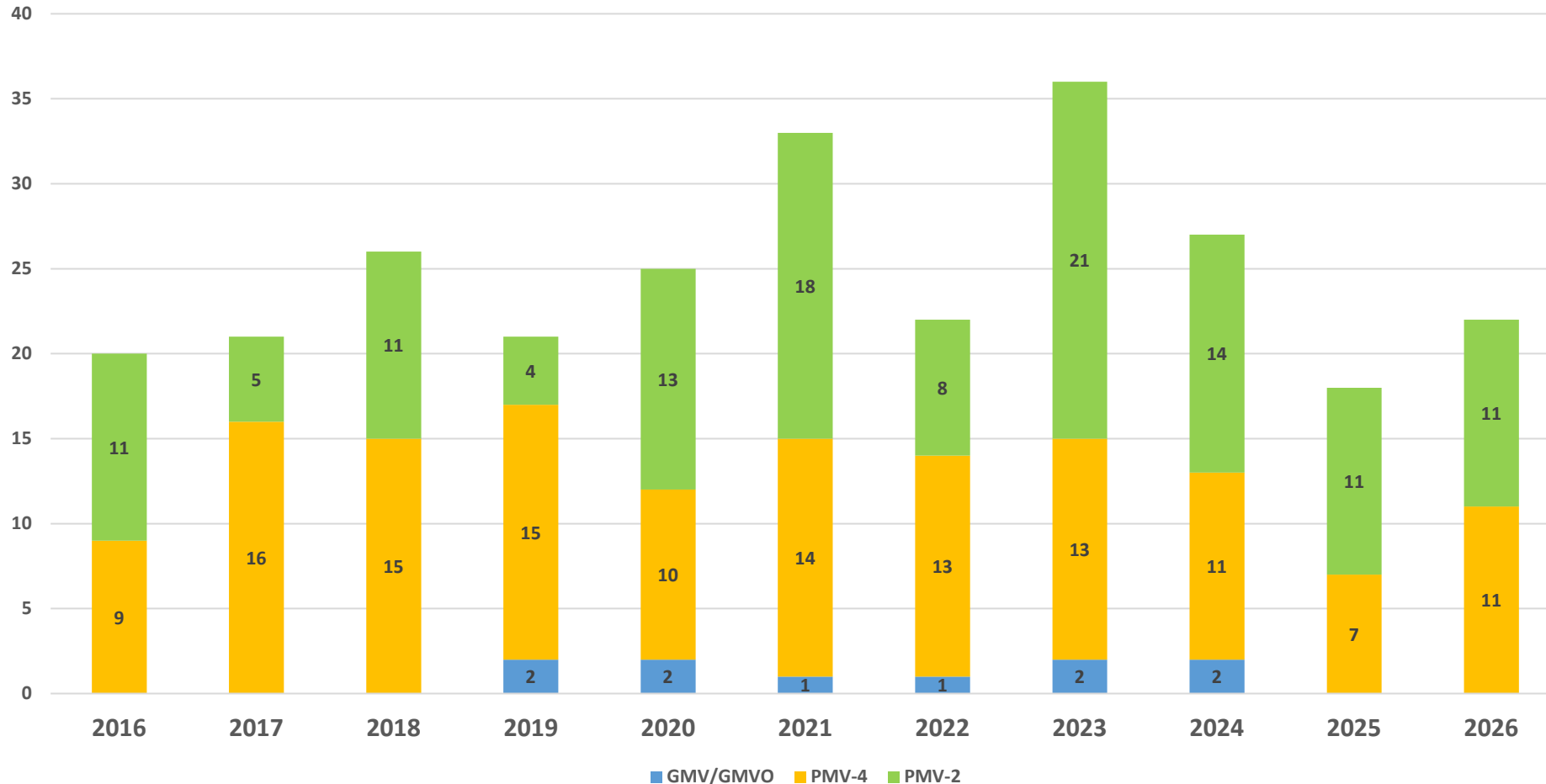

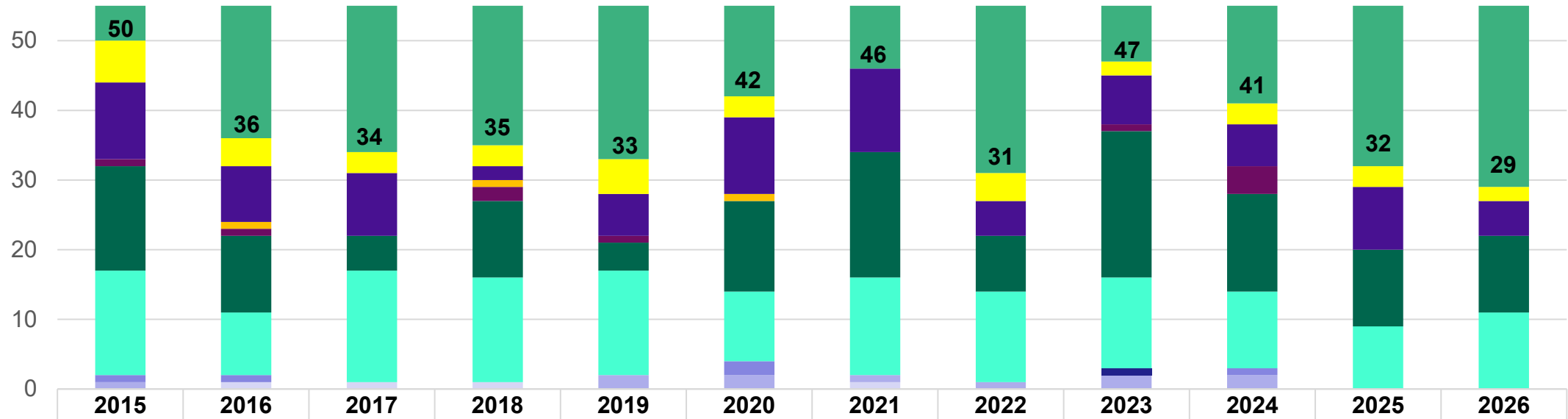
