SUBJECT: 101 Critical Days of Summer

- 1. Spring is in the air, and the fun of summer is just around the corner. Unfortunately, this is also a period of increased mishaps and injuries across the DAF team. The 101 Critical Days of Summer begin on Memorial Day and run through Labor Day. This summer, we must use sound decision-making and risk management skills during all our activities to protect ourselves, our families, and our teammates.
- 2. We lost 19-members to preventable mishaps during this period last year. The leading cause of fatalities continues to be motor vehicle accidents exacerbated by reckless driving, fatigue, speeding, and alcohol. The average age of Airmen and Guardians involved in these events is under 30-years old. *First-line supervisors are our most critical and first line of defense—get in front of our Airmen and Guardians and discuss the risks*. Mentor them to ensure they are making the best decisions for themselves and the mission.

- 4. Our Airmen, Guardians, civilians, and families are our most valuable assets. They are the heart of America's combat power.
